

JAA TYPE CONVERSION PROGRAM

Program Description

This program is designed to provide the required conversion training for ICAO CPL/IR ATPL ME holders to meet the level of proficiency necessary to operate single-pilot multi-engine aircrafts and to obtain JAR CPL/IR ATPL ME. Holders of this license are eligible for employment as airline pilots throughout Europe.

What is a JAA License ?

The Joint Aviation Authority (JAA) is an associated body of the European Civil Aviation Conference (ECAC), representing the civil aviation regulatory authorities of the European countries who have agreed to co-operate in developing and implementing common safety regulatory standards and procedures. This co-operation is intended to provide high and consistent standards of safety and a "level playing-field" for competition in Europe. Much emphasis is also placed on harmonizing the JAA regulations with those of the USA.

In order to fly in a country that is part of the JAA and also to fly a aircraft which is registered in a JAA member country, you need to hold a Joint Aviation Regulation Flight Crew License (JAR FCL). This license, however, is not easy to attain. The theoretical knowledge requirements for the JAR FCL are the highest in the world.
