ISSUES	QUESTION	ANSWER
VISA	What kind of visa required to undergo PPL training in Malaysia and CPL training in United Kingdom ?	You are required to obtain a ‘Professional Visit Pass’ for PPL training in Malaysia, and a ‘Student Pass’ for CPL training in the United Kingdom.
	How long are the visas valid for ? Renewable ?	The visas are valid for the duration of the training period offered by flight school. It is renewable.
	How long is the process of submission to issuance ?	The visa approval will take about 5 working days from the date of submission. However, should you be required to attend an interview session at the Embassy, the process, otherwise, would be approximately 1 month.
	Do I need to acquire the training visas for Malaysia and United Kingdom in Japan ?	All required visas to undergo training will be applied in Malaysia.
	Can I work part-time under the these visas ?	You are NOT permitted to work part-time or full time under the condition of such visa.
	Is it for multiple entry or single entry ?	The visas are for multiple entry.
MEDICAL	Where can I have my medical check-up done ?	All medical check-ups will be done in Malaysia with DCA-M and JAA approved panel medical examiners.
	What type of medical class required for PPL and CPL/IR ATPL Frozen ME trainings ?	DCA-M Class II Medical Certification for PPL and JAA Class I Medical Certification for CPL/IR ATPL Frozen ME.
	How much is the medical check-up ?	Kindly refer to the price quotation.
	How long do I need for medical approval ?	Medical certification to be issued on the spot if the trainee pass the required medical checks.

LICENSE	What is the difference between JAA and JAR FCL ?	<p>The Joint Aviation Authority (JAA) is an associated body of the European Civil Aviation Conference (ECAC), representing the civil aviation regulatory authorities of the European countries who have agreed to co-operate in developing and implementing common safety regulatory standards and procedures. This co-operation is intended to provide high and consistent standards of safety and a "level playing-field" for competition in Europe. Much emphasis is also placed on harmonizing the JAA regulations with those of the USA.</p> <p>In order to fly in a country that is part of the JAA and also to fly a aircraft which is registered in a JAA member country, you need to hold a <u>Joint Aviation Regulation Flight Crew License</u> (JAR FCL). This license, however, is not easy to attain. The theoretical knowledge requirements for the JAR FCL are the highest in the world.</p>
	If I have a valid ICAO PPL, do I need to convert to Malaysia DCA PPL to clock my flight hours ?	ICAO PPL holders, apart from Malaysia will be required to sit for an 'AIR LAW' and 'HUMAN PERFORMANCE & LIMITATION' papers before clocking the flight hours in Malaysia.
	I have fulfilled the CPL entry requirements. Am I required to convert my Private Pilot License to JAR ?	It is NOT required to convert your ICAO PPL to JAR PPL if you have fulfilled the JAR CPL entry requirements.
	Is JAR License recognized in other foreign countries ?	Yes. JAR License is recognized in any of the JAA Member State and ICAO Contracting States.
	What is the duration of PPL training in Malaysia ?	PPL training in Malaysia will take approximately 12 months including clocking your flight hours.
	What is the duration of CPL/IR ATPL Frozen ME training in United Kingdom ?	CPL/IR ATPL Frozen ME training in United Kingdom will take approximately 11 months.
	How much is the total fees for training ?	Kindly refer to the price quotation.
	How long is my JAR License valid for ?	JAR License is valid up to the age of 60.

ACADEMIC	What are the minimum academic requirements to enrol in the Professional Pilot Program ?	Applicant must be competent in the use of the English language and a sound knowledge of basic mathematics and physics.
	Is English proficiency a must ?	Yes. All ground syllabus and flight exams will be conducted in English.
	How to determine my English proficiency is able to cope with the training ?	We would strongly suggest the applicant to undergo an intensive English course and tested for TOEIC / IELTS.
LIVING QUARTERS	What is the distance from the accommodation to the flight school ?	Accommodation is within the campus of the flight school.
	Is it a twin-sharing or single room ?	Accommodation in Malaysia comes with bedding, a study room, laundry facilities and kitchen utensils and is available on a shared-basis. In the United Kingdom, the accommodation is an ensuite single room and shared use of the large kitchen.
	How much is the room per month ?	Kindly refer to the price quotation.
INSURANCE	Am I insured for any mishaps (sickness, surgery etc.) in Malaysia and United Kingdom ?	Unfortunately we do not cover medical insurance during your training period in Malaysia and United Kingdom.

GENERAL	Are there any form of restrictions for foreigners to enrol in Professional Pilot Program ?	There are no specific restrictions apply to foreigners. However, foreign applicants must have appropriate visa and comply to the requirements stated within.
	Is there any age restriction to enrol in Professional Pilot Program ?	Minimum age at enrolment must exceed 17 years old.
